Living 21, a part of the British Legion not for profit organisation, held a pre-application consultation event at Darley Abbey; their plans are to submit a planning application to develop the Bath Street Mills site. The historic Grade II listed Mill building was seriously damaged in a fire, and is located on the west side of the river

Derwent on the other side of Handyside Bridge. The proposal is to demolish the existing building and build a new four storey building of approximately 80 flats. Sixty flats for rent and twenty for purchase would be available for the over fifty age group with facilities for extra care where needed. The designs include a flood wall around the building to protect it.
