#### LITTLE CHESTER RESIDENTS'ASSOCIATION

A number of planning applications have been submitted by the Flood Defence Project Our City Our River.

#### 03/17/00368 Two three storey office blocks and 186 metre flood wall on 14-16 & Contractors Yard City Rd (the former Tomlinsons site)

There are concerns that whilst the proposed offices have capacity for over 200 workers, there are only 42 proposed parking spaces on the application site.

It's believed that the applicant, Prime Construction, are leaseholders of the neighbouring site, which is currently being used for parking.

#### 03/17/00271 Sports Provision on **Darley Playing Fields**

Erection of tennis courts, artificial sports pitch, informal sports area with sports wall, outdoor gym equipment & access path.

The layout of this area has been reconfigured since the previous plans. Larger tennis courts which can host club matches have been relocated to the 'wet side' of the flood wall. OCOR say the previous 'dry side' location to the west side of the car park access road would have caused damage to archaeology and adversely impacted on nearby properties & views from Old Chester Rd.

04/17/00454 Revised City Rd Garages area Secure Parking Compound for use by Aida staff. Following a previous

refusal by the Planning Committee. designs have been amended to include metal fencing, Victorian style lighting columns and low level planting.

#### 04/17/0512 Unit 2c City Rd (the former Shisha bar)

A new Gable Wall.

#### **Severn Trent Insurance**

Their has been no response from Severn Trent (as of 21/4/17) to the request for them to review their inadequate compensation offer following the burst water main on Mansfield Rd. The Residents Association will continue to lobby our Ward Councillors and MP to endeavour to achieve a satisfactory resolution.

#### **Alfreton Rd Waste Incinerator** 10/16/01241

The scheduled hearing at the Planning Committee meeting of 13<sup>th</sup> April of Envirofusion's application was postponed, due to a planning technicality.

#### 33 Apartment Five Storey application 12/14/01708

A revised application has been submitted for 12 -14 Mansfield Rd, the former Anochrome Jigs' site adjacent to Landau Forte school.






