Flood Defence Update

Representatives from the Resident's Association discussed progress on the Chester Green Flood Defence Scheme with members of the OCOR Team in June. The key developments included:

When will it be finished?

The Chester Green phase of the scheme including landscaping, tree planting, regrassing, etc. is due to be completed by April 2018.

Aida/Bliss Factory buildings

The council's purchase of the buildings has been agreed in principle and legal formalities are being completed. The building has been subject to ongoing vandalism and the current owners have failed to secure the building or make it safe. The OCOR team has now secured the rear doors, fencing off the deep pits and are waiting to seal the windows at the back to try to prevent access. Once the buildings are purchased the rear newer buildings will be demolished and the whole site made secure. The council expect the eventual development on that site to be residential. Expect a planning application and consultation in late 2018.

City Road garages

Work to erect a new secure parking area for Aida employees will commence on the bottom section of the City Road garage site as soon as the purchase of the Aida buildings has been completed. Request has been made to upgrade the current lighting in the area and severe pruning of the conifers to improve security and safety of local residents using the area

Tomlinson's Factory

The planning application 03/17/00368 for office buildings on this site cannot be decided yet owing to the failure to

include a flood risk assessment. Work is expected to begin on this site in September. Some concern was expressed about the limited number of parking spaces included in the application. We were informed that this is in line with transport policy on this issue ie people who work near the city centre are encouraged to use public transport.

Magnus Court / Centurian Walk way closure – Owing to what was described as "horrendous' dog fouling the park area between these 2 developments was closed recently frustrating and annoying many people. The council are investigating the owners responsible for the dog fouling and want to reopen the area following consultation with residents.

Parkers Piece Pavilion - OCOR have commissioned a full survey of the pavilion to identify what needs to be done to bring it up to modern standards for future use. There are some parties interested in using the cricket pitch. Nets, which were formerly on Darley playing fields, will be located there and an artificial wicket is being considered.

Art Work – Consultations about forms of heritage art have taken place with local residents. A request for some poetry which relates to the area is requested. The LCRA can pass this on if desired

Opening ceremony – An event to mark the completion of the scheme next year is being suggested. Please let OCOR or LCRA have any ideas or suggestions.
