Older Drivers' Car Insurance

Research by Which?, the consumer champion, suggests that average premiums paid by certain older age groups are totally out of proportion to their risk. Which? have analysed premium quotes given directly online to find out which are the cheapest insurers by age bracket for older drivers. Their findings are as follows:

Age	Cheapest Insurer
51 to 60	Swiftcover
61 to 65	Sheila's Wheels
66 to 70	The Co-operative Insurance
71 plus	Esure

You may find it worthwhile getting quotes from these insurers at your next renewal, as haggling or switching insurers can often save you significant costs. If you aren't online you can of course contact them by phone. Do remember to check that conditions like excesses are suitable for you.

Mobile Phone Security Measures

Local police officers would like to ask residents and businesses to record the IMEI number from their phone in case it is ever lost or stolen. The unique number is used by a phone network to identify valid devices and therefore can be used for stopping a phone from accessing that network. For example, if a mobile phone is stolen, the owner can call their network provider and instruct them to "blacklist" the phone using its IMEI number. This renders the phone useless on that network and sometimes other networks too, whether or not the phone's SIM is changed.

The IMEI numbers can be found in several ways; sometimes the number may be on the back of the phone, it may be on the battery or in certain models the number will be recorded on the SIM tray. You can also find the IMEI number of the phone if it is still switched on by dialing *#06#.

You can register this number through www.immobilise.com who will keep your details and can enable the police to trace the owner of any recovered phone.
